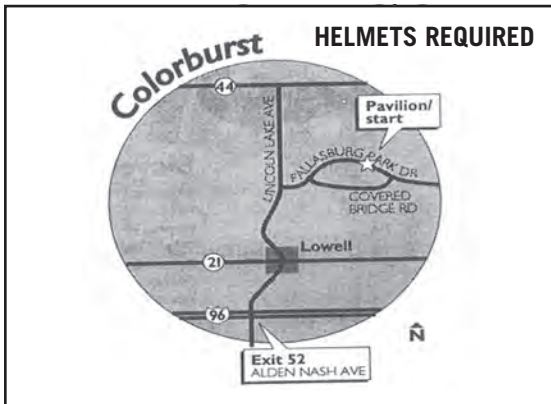

(a brief) Colorburst History

Colorburst was started in 1983 by Craig
Campbell, a Rapid Wheelmen Bicycle Club
member, as a memorial to Donna Ryskamp
who, while bicycling on August 9, 1983, was
killed by a drunk driver.

On August 29, 1987 Craig Campbell was killed
when a car driven by a drunk driver struck his
motorcycle. Craig was driving the route for
Colorburst 1987 before printing the map for
the ride.

Now in it's 34th year, the Colorburst Bicycle
Tour continues to honor Donna and Craig, and
has raised over \$120,000+ dollars for MADD
and other local bicycle related charities.
